The MINDSET consortium met in Austria in April to discuss the next steps of the Capacity Building Program after it was tested by the youth workers at the LTTA.

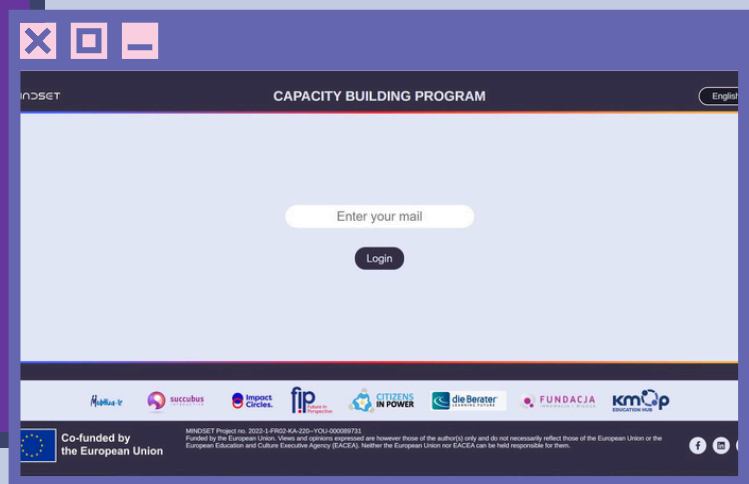
As always, it was a very productive gathering!

We are just finishing the translation of all materials for Work Package 3 of our project, the Capacity Building Program (CBP), into the languages of our partnership: French, German, Greek, Polish, and Portuguese. This includes:

- Action Sheets
- Self-evaluation questionnaires for youth
- Self-evaluation questionnaires for youth workers

In September 2024, everything will be uploaded to the **eLearning Platform** and in October 2024, the **Pilot Testing** will begin in all 8 partner countries.
